1.0. INTRODUCTION

2.0. CRITERIA FOR SELECTING BENEFICIAL STUDENTS

2.1. To be eligible for the scholarship, student(s) shall meet the following criteria:

- a) Enrolled at MUST under a Degree programme related to communication;
- b) Not older than 22 years at the time of application;
- c) Have formally submitted an application for the UCSAF Scholarship;
- d) Demonstrate financial need, supported by relevant documentary evidence;
- e) Be a citizen and resident of the United Republic of Tanzania.

2.2. In selecting beneficial student(s), the following factors shall be considered

- a) Academic performance in Advanced Secondary Education;
- b) Academic performance at Ordinary Secondary Education;
- c) Financial need of the applicant (Please, attach evidence)

3.0. SPONSORED DEGREE PROGRAMMES

The following Degree programmes shall be included in the scholarship:

- a) Bachelor of Science in Information and Communication Technology,

- b) Bachelor of Engineering in Telecommunication Systems,
- c) Bachelor of Engineering in Data Science.

4.0. SCOPE OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO BENEFICIAL STUDENT(S)

Financial assistance to be offered to beneficial student(s) may include the following items:
